### **GENERAL DAMAGES**

Compensation for pain & suffering

#### Restrictions

#### The Threshold

You must meet the statutory threshold (Ontario Insurance Act) in order to be compensated for your pain and suffering. The threshold requires:

- 1. Permanent impairment; and
- 2. Serious impairment.

#### The Deductible

Any award less than \$155,965.54 is subject to a deductible of \$46,790.05 as of 2025.

### SPECIAL DAMAGES

Compensation for financial losses

### Past & Future Loss of Income

- 1. You are only entitled to 70% of your past gross income loss;
- 2. You are not entitled to any income loss for the 7 days following the accident; and
- 3. You are entitled to 100% of your future loss of income.

## Example of Other Special Damages

- » Out-of-pocket expenses
- » Housekeeping
- » Future care costs



<sup>1</sup> Section 267.5(5) of the Ontario Insurance Act states that a person injured in a car accident is not entitled to general damages unless the injured person has died or has sustained: (a) permanent serious disfigurement; or (b) permanent serious impairment of an important physical, mental or psychological function.
